

Note: This Adult Rehabilitation Kit is for a new listener or a listener developing confidence with their hearing technology. If you are unsure where to start, simply begin at Level 1. All recipients will benefit from all activities, even if they seem simple at first. This helps build listening endurance and confidence.

How to choose a level

Level 1	The recipient is learning to discriminate words of differing syllable number. The recipient is learning to understand words when they are at the end of a sentence and when they have differing acoustic characteristics. Tips

This material is suitable for recipients who have had their hearing device fitted or cochlear implant processor switched on for a period of two weeks or more.

Check the recipient's hearing at the beginning of every rehabilitation session using the Ling Six Sound Test.

- Find a strategy for giving the recipient instructions for each activity. You might need to write the instructions down or you can use the instructions on these pages and point to the words as you read them.
- Ensure that the recipient understands all the information that is provided throughout the session. For example, if you speak to another family member, ensure that the recipient can access what was said. It may be necessary to write it down. It is important for the recipient to be included and valued as a participant in all discussions throughout the session.
- It is often helpful to do a trial of each activity together to ensure the recipient knows what they are required to do. Building confidence in recipients is important. Remember that activities that are easy are still useful to build confidence and increase listening endurance. Do not rush to harder activities.
- When using paper or a hand to limit visual access, be sure a good auditory signal is received. Ensure the sound is not muffled by the screen.
- Remember that the activities can be tiring for the recipient. Ensure there are some breaks between activities when the recipient can relax (e.g., getting a drink of water, stretching) before beginning the next activity.
- For Hearing Lifestyle activities, easy access to information is recommended. This can be achieved by allowing access to lip-reading or by reading the information.

- 4. Randomly pick a word in each sentence to stop after. The recipient then says what the next word in the sentence would be.

FAMOUS PEOPLE AND HEARING LOSS

- Whoopi Goldberg wears hearing aids. She attributes her hearing loss to years of listening to loud music.
- Lou Ferrigno, the Incredible Hulk from TV, lost his hearing at the age of three due to an ear infection. He's worn hearing aids since he was four. He told an interviewer in 2005, "I think my hearing loss helped create a determination within me to be all I can be and gave me a certain strength of character too."
- Bill Clinton has high-frequency hearing loss and wears two in-the-canal hearing aids. He says he finds it difficult to hear in noisy situations such as restaurants.
- Rush Limbaugh, the famous American talk show host, has two cochlear implants. He got his first in 2001 and his second in 2014. He said, "Coming from total deafness, it is miraculous!"
- Pete Townshend, from the famous band *The Who*, has noise induced hearing loss, and tinnitus. *The Who* held a concert in England where the volume 30 metres form the stage was recorded at 126 decibels. He has supported charitable efforts such as the non-profit hearing advocacy group H.E.A.R (Hearing Education and Awareness for Rockers).
- Arnold Palmer, an American professional golfer, who is regarded as one of the greatest players in the sport's history. His hearing loss was discovered at the age of 40. He wears a hearing aid.
- Jean-Christoph Novelli is a French-born British celebrity chef who was diagnosed with severe hearing loss at age 52. He said decades spent in noisy kitchens made the problem worse. He had to strain so hard to follow conversations that he got headaches and a stiff neck. He was fitted with a hearing aid and now urges people over 50 to get their hearing tested.
